Resident Celebrity: Ginny Tyler

Providence Marianwood is nestled in the woods but that doesn't explain the sound of chipmunks coming from the hallways. And the voices of Polynesia, the parrot from Dr. Doolittle and Olive Oyl.

But when you find out that Marianwood is home to Ginny Tyler, a famous talent in television and film who was inducted into the Disney Legends Hall of Fame in 2006, it begins to make sense!

Ginny grew up in a story-telling family near Seattle and her family taught her the storytelling craft and to imitate animal sounds and bird calls. Her spunky personality as well as her vocal talents put her in front of a radio microphone in 1941 and by 1951, she was hosting her own daily children's show on KOMO-TV,

"Magic Island". She also got a lot of off-screen work with her voice talents and in 1957, Ginny moved to Hollywood.

She joined the Disneyland Records company and narrated the beloved and now classic vinyl recordings of Bambi, Babes in Toyland, Hans Brinker and More Mother Goose. She joined the Mickey Mouse Club and became "Head Mouseketeer", hosting a 45-minute daily segment of the "Mickey Mouse Club" live from the Main Street Opera House at Disneyland.

Ginny also became famous for her character voices. She voiced "Casper the Friendly Ghost" for TV as well as parts in Space Ghost, Fantastic Four, The Adventures of Gulliver and Dav-
