Practitioners* specializing in areas of medicine where fluoroscopy is part of the core training as defined by the individual board certification organization of that specialty must provide evidence of current board certification/eligibility (Cardiology, Radiology and Radiology Oncology).</p> <p style="text-align: center;">OR</p> <p>2. a. Documentation that the practitioner* was trained to do Fluoroscopy. (Physicians who are members of the Medical Staff of PRMCE performing fluoroscopy as of January 1, 2010 will be grandfathered in for this requirement).</p> <p style="text-align: center;">AND</p> <p>2. b. Upon initial appointment or upon first reappointment after criteria are approved, review of the PRMCE Policy on Fluoroscopy, the Medical Staff Policy on the minimum standards of fluoroscopy, and the Radiation Safety Manual for Fluoroscopists.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">AND</p> <p>2. c. Successful completion and return of the Fluoroscopy Safety Examination.</p>	<p>None</p> <p>3 mentored cases by Fluoro credentialed staff member for practitioners appointed to medical staff after January 1, 2010.</p>	<p>If badge readings are over the quarterly level 2 maximum as defined by NRC and Radiation Safety Committee, then completion of 2b and 2c is expected.</p>	12/2009
